Moab Irrigation Company Policy

At the February, 2022 Board Meeting, the Directors of the Company set a policy that to prevent degradation of acre foot per share amounts, only 60% of the shares of the company can be moved to diversion points above the two lower valley diversion dams for the purpose of using surface water from the main fork of Mill Creek.

Distribution of Shares in the Company based on CFS

Moab Irrigation Company's water right allocates the company 19.33 CFS of water.

There are 1080 shares in the company.

Therefore 1 CFS equals 55.97 shares

Of the 19.33 CFS --

4.43 comes from North Fork of Mill Creek.

14.9 CFS from the Main Fork of Mill Creek.

Ken's Lake and all mountain diversions obtain water from the main fork of Mill Creek.

The Lake is required by the BLM to allow 3.0 CFS to flow pass the Sheley tunnel diversion dam.

This means that 7.43 CFS flows to the lower valley and cannot be utilized above the lower valley.

The distribution of the shares based on CFS is -

415 shares should remain in the lower valley – 38%

665 shares could go to users above the lower valley diversions – 62%

In 2022 the share distribution 1s as follows -

Total for lower valley Diversions – 429 shares – 40% (includes wells and lower valley springs)

Total for above the lower Diversions - 651 shares – 60% (includes mtn. springs)
